





Confirming Video Summaries

Below are instructions for confirming video summaries. This is not a peer review, but a confirmation that the video content matches the research in the article. If you find no issues with the video, please send an approval message to the Managing Editor (you do not need to add any justification). If you feel that the video does not match the research in the article, please provide a 1-2 statements regarding any concerns with the video (maybe longer if issues are noted below).

Examples of issues to note:

- Although quality will be checked prior to your review please note any quality issues with the video (example: audio is quiet, or audio doesn't match slide presentation, video is blurry, etc.)
- false claims
- inappropriate content
- content including libel or slander claims
- content that is misused or plagiarized
- advertisement for product or service

These elements are ok:

additional branding by Institution, Company

Again, either return concerns or a confirmation message to the managing editor. If you have additional questions, please contact your managing editor.
