Flagging for Promotion

The Societies regularly promote the work of their authors via their blogs, magazines, podcast, social media accounts, newsletters, and other channels. If you find a paper that you feel is worthy of promotion, please flag it for promotion.

To flag a paper, first scroll to the flags at the bottom of the manuscript information tab. Check the gray circle with the checkmark "flag for promotion" flag and hit save. The flag will show up at the top of the manuscript.

When you make your recommendation, you will see a section regarding whether the article should be promoted and why. Please fill out this section as applicable before you submit your recommendation.
